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# AWS EXPERT ADVISORY GROUP ON WATER FOR SANITATION AND HYGIENE

## TERMS OF REFERENCE

### Background

The Alliance for Water Stewardship (AWS) is a global membership-based collaboration, which unites organizations behind its mission: to lead a global network that promotes responsible use of freshwater that is socially and economically beneficial and environmentally sustainable.

AWS achieves this through a global water stewardship system, centred on the International Water Stewardship Standard (the AWS Standard) that drives, recognizes and rewards good water stewardship performance.

AWS is undertaking a review and revision of the Standard and the systems that support its implementation. The AWS Technical Committee is leading the review of the Standard. The Committee acknowledges that how issues relating to water for sanitation and hygiene (WASH) are addressed and treated by the Standard requires expertise and knowledge which is outside of the Committee's current knowledge base.

AWS has formed an Expert Advisory Group, made up of AWS members with particular expertise in the field of WASH in order to provide specialist advice to the Committee in its review of the Standard.

### Purpose

The purpose of the WASH Expert Advisory Group is to:

- Consider the current indicator (4.7.1) for Criteria 4.7 within the Standard, and whether a minimum or threshold level of WASH access for workers can and should be included within the indicator;
- Consider whether the current guidance within the Standard relating to Criteria 4.7 is adequate and/or requires improvement or amendment;
- consider what specific guidance should be included within the AWS Standard relating to gender issues and WASH; and
- provide advice and recommendations to the AWS Technical Committee on the above matters.

## Membership

Membership of the WASH Expert Advisory Group is as follows:

## The Chairperson

The Advisory Group will determine whether it requires a Chair, and if so, will appoint a Chair from within the Advisory Group's membership.

## Communication and meetings

## Confidentiality

The Advisory Group will operate per Chatham House Rules. So, while members of the Group have full authority to share any non-confidential substance of discussions and papers, they shall not report or attribute either the comments of individuals nor their affiliations outside of meetings, whether conducted face to face or virtually.

The confidentiality agreement shall continue beyond the retirement of the member from the Group.

## Reporting

The Advisory Group will report back to AWS and the Technical Committee by XXXXX. This report shall be in writing and will include a series of recommendations for consideration by the Committee.

**Term**

The Advisory Group's term will be considered complete upon provision of its report (including recommendations) to the AWS Technical Committee.
